

## Parent/Carer Guide for Coronavirus Scenarios

What to do if my child...	Action	My child can return to school when...
<p><b>has even just 1 coronavirus symptom</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Temperature of 37.8 or above</li> <li>• New continuous cough for over an hour or 3 or more coughing episodes within a 24 hour period.</li> <li>• Loss of sense of taste or smell</li> </ul>	<p><b>Do not come to school</b> Whole family must self-isolate <b>Get a test</b> Inform school immediately about test result</p>	<p>Their test comes back negative</p>
<p><b>tests positive for Coronavirus</b></p>	<p><b>Do not come to school</b> Self-isolate for 14 days after the first sign of symptoms Inform school immediately of test result</p> <p>Your child must keep self-isolating if they still have any of these symptoms after 14 days:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- a high temperature</li> <li>- feeling hot and shivery</li> <li>- a runny nose or sneezing</li> <li>- feeling or being sick</li> <li>- diarrhoea</li> <li>- loss of appetite</li> </ul> <p>Only stop self-isolating when these symptoms have gone.</p>	<p>After they have self-isolated for 14 days after the first sign of symptoms.</p> <p>They can return to school even if they have a cough or loss of smell/taste. These symptoms can last for several weeks once the infection has gone</p>
<p><b>is in a household with someone who has coronavirus symptoms</b></p>	<p><b>Do not come to school</b> Self-isolate Household member to <b>get a test</b> Inform school immediately of test result</p>	<p>The household member's test is negative</p>
<p><b>is in a household with someone who has tested positive for coronavirus</b></p>	<p><b>Do not come to school</b> Self-isolate for 14 days</p>	<p>Your child has completed 14 days of self-isolation</p>
<p><b>has been identified as a close contact of somebody with symptoms or confirmed coronavirus by NHS Test and Trace</b></p>	<p><b>Do not come to school</b> Self-isolate for 14 days</p>	<p>Your child has completed 14 days of self-isolation</p> <p>If your child becomes unwell within those 14 days, they must get tested.</p>
<p><b>has travelled to a destination where quarantine is needed</b></p>	<p><b>Do not come to school</b> Self-isolate for 14 days</p>	<p>The quarantine period has been completed</p>
<p><b>has received medical advice that they must resume shielding</b></p>	<p><b>Do not come to school</b> Contact the school Shield as advised</p>	<p>You have been informed that restrictions have been lifted and your child is no longer needing to shield.</p>
<p><b>lives with someone who has been identified as a close contact of somebody with symptoms or confirmed coronavirus by NHS Test and Trace</b></p>	<p><b>Do not come to school</b> Whole household must self-isolate for 14 days</p>	<p>Your child has completed 14 days of self-isolation</p> <p>If your child becomes unwell within those 14 days, they must get tested.</p>
