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Attendance and Punctuality

- Attendance and achievement go hand in hand. Poor attendance can result in academic underachievement, difficulty in making or keeping friends and loss of child's confidence.
- Punctuality – **it is vital** (to ensure the health and safety of all) that your child is dropped off at and collected from school at the designated time and place.



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Children walking home alone

Children in Year 5 and 6 are allowed to walk home alone, but will only be permitted to do so once written parental has been given written permission to walk home alone, they will be allowed to bring a mobile phone to school. However, they must be switched off and handed into the class teacher as soon as the child arrives in class. Any mobile phones discovered or reported on a child's person or in their bags will be confiscated and will need to be collected from the school office at a mutually convenient time.
